2023/041

MATTERS ARISING 2023/042

- a) The Dorset Council Housing Strategy consultation was noted. Cllr Ostler pointed out that there were lots of interesting facts within the consultation, including that Dorset has the biggest retirement population in England, although second homes were not detailed. ACTION: Clerk to respond about the lack of genuinely affordable housing and the impacts of second homes on residents.
- **b)** The purchase of a defibrillator was considered and possible siting locations were discussed.

ACTION: Cllr Guthrie to request consent for siting defibrillator.

c) The DAPTC AGM is scheduled to take place on Saturday 14 November. No motions were proposed.

a) Cllr Guthrie had met with Highways for an extensive tour around the parish, prior to road resurfacing being carried out. There were several areas thought to need further

attention. It was agreed that a request should be made to the new Highways Officer to attend to look at areas requiring repair.

- **b)** Cllr Ostler requested that ongoing matters be detailed on the agenda. Spring bulbs had been agreed previously and this was discussed. It was resolved to purchase and plant some tête-à-têtes.
- c) Cllr Ostler proposed a bench at the top of Five Marys. It was agreed that permissions should be sought and costs acquired to bring for discussion at the next meeting.
